Press Release

08/31/17 through 09/11/17

31-Aug-17 An Akron resident reported that a neighbor took his cat trap, released a trapped cat and destroyed the trap. Case is under investigation.

31-Aug-17 Deputies were called to a harassment concern at the park. After talking to the involved parties they were told to leave each other alone.

31-Aug-17 Deputies made a traffic stop for speeding on Hwy 34. Upon contact, it was determined that George Berg was driving under the influence of Alcohol, Drugs or both. He was arrested and charged with DUI, speeding, open alcohol container, and open marijuana container in a vehicle. Mr. Berg was transported to Washington County Justice Center and later released on a \$2000.00 PR Bond.

01-Sept-17 Deputies made a traffic stop for speeding on Hwy 34. Upon contact, it was determined that Dustin Krayca was driving under the influence of drugs. He was arrested and charged with DUI, Possession of 2oz or less of marijuana, and unlawful possession of a controlled substance. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and later released on a \$10,000.00 surety bond.

01-Sept-17 Deputies noticed suspicious activity at the Washington County Fairground Walking Trail. Upon further investigation a juvenile gave the deputies a recovered lap top that was said to be found on the trail. It was later determined that the lap top that was found belonged to the Akron Public Schools. The lap top was later returned to the School. Case is under investigation.

01-Sept-10 Deputies received a report of a bicycle theft in the Town of Akron. The bike was found later by an individual. Case is under investigation.

02-Sept-17 Deputies made a traffic stop for speeding. While speaking to the driver of the vehicle she kept looking down at something. Deputies looked in the window and found a firearm in the door. The firearm had 2 rounds in it that were not chambered. Deputies also found a .22 caliber firearm next to the passenger, the firearm was not loaded. Deputies arrested Dianne Walz for fictitious license tabs and driving without valid insurance. Deputies also arrested Lonnie Whitney for unlawful distribution/Manufacturing/Dispensing/Sale/Possession, Possession of weapon by a previous offender, Possession of illegal weapon & Violation of Bail Bonds. After obtaining a search warrant for the vehicle, deputies recovered ammunition, knives, methamphetamine, prescription pills, marijuana, a digital scale, drug paraphernalia & cash. Ms. Walz was released on a \$1000.00 surety bond. Mr. Whitney is being held pending advisement.

02-Sept-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible gas leak in the Town of Akron. Deputies were advised the leak was caused from a vehicle striking a gas meter. After further investigation deputies arrested David Kendall on charges of DUI. Mr. Kendall was later released on a \$2000.00 bond.

03-Sept-17 Deputies received a report of possible harassment at the Akron City Park. Case is under investigation.

04-Sept-17 Deputies received a report of a trespass in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

04-Sept-17 Deputies received a report of some mischief at the playground at Akron Schools. The suspect(s) had drawn on the equipment with a deodorant stick and left various items of gym clothes strewn about the area.

04-Sept-17 Deputies responded to a residence in the Town of Akron when neighbors noticed that a door

was open on a building under renovation. Upon further investigation it was determined that the door was probably not locked and the wind had blown it open.

04-Sept-17 While deputies were attempting to locate the owner of stray dogs they located an infant on a porch unattended. The parents were located and DHS was notified of the situation.

04-Sept-17 Deputies received a report of a dog at large. The dog was located and taken to the Akron Pound. The dog's owner, Stuart Travis later came to pick up the dog.

06-Sept-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible vandalism in the 700 block of Elm in the Town of Akron. Deputies arrived on scene and observed a shattered window on a vehicle parked in the back of the residence. Case is under investigation.

06-Sept-17 While in custody, Ethan Mason was arrested on a warrant out of Hamilton County District Court in Kansas. He is being held on a \$18,000.00 bond.

07-Sept-17 Deputies received a report of a disturbance in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival it was determined that no criminal acts had occurred.

07-Sept-17 Several ordinances were issued in the Town of Akron for violations.

07-Sept-17 While in custody, Lenora Ribellia was arrested on three warrants out of Larimer County courts. Two of the warrants are no bond and the other warrant has a \$240.00 bond.
