10/20/17 through 10/27/17

- 20-Oct-17 Deputies observed a tree growing on a public road in the Town of Otis. The owner was informed of the violation and given a verbal warning to trim the tree.
- 22-Oct-17 Deputies received a report of a cold Domestic in the Town of Akron. The suspect, Mike Armbrust was later arrested in Morgan County. Armbrust was later transported to Washington County Justice Center on no bond pending advisement by a judge.
- 23-Oct-17 Deputies arrested Ellen Heinitz on a Logan County warrant for failure to appear. Heinitz was later transported to Logan County.
- 24-Oct-17 Deputies responded to a medical call in the Town of Akron. The resident was transported to the hospital and his dog was taken to the Akron Pound for the safety of the dog.
- 25-Oct-17 Deputies observed trash scattered at a residence in the Town of Akron. The owner was informed of the violation and given a verbal warning to clean up the trash.
- 25-Oct-17 Deputies were dispatched to a traffic accident on Hwy 34 & CO RD GG involving a car and a deer. There were no injuries and the vehicle didn't sustain any damage.
- 26-Oct-17 Deputies were dispatched to a dog at large in the Town of Akron. Deputies took the dog to the Akron Pound. The dog's owner later pickup up the dog and was given a verbal warning.
- 26-Oct-17 Deputies were contacted by probations about a juvenile who had a probation violation. The juvenile was arrested and transported to Platte Valley Detention Center.
- 27-Oct-17 Deputies were dispatched to a stolen vehicle in the Town of Otis. Upon further investigation it was found that the vehicle had been taken somewhere between Sept 22nd and Sept 27th. The vehicle was later recovered and released to the owner. Case is under investigation.
