06-Oct-17 Deputies impounded a relinquished dog from the Town of Otis. Due to no one adopting the dog it was later taken to the Denver Dumb Friends League.

06-Oct-17 Deputies received a report of a possible criminal mischief in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival deputies observed nails had been put in the driveway of the residence. This case is under investigation.

06-Oct-17 Deputies responded to shots fired call in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival it was discovered that Christopher Eskew had a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

08-Oct-17 Deputies responded to a residence in the 100 block of 5th Ave on a possible burglary. Deputies searched the residence and found no occupants. The windows had been unlocked and one of the windows was broken. Case is under investigation.

08-Oct-17 Deputies were dispatched to a fight in the Town of Akron. Upon further investigation Saul Stillwell was issued a summons for disorderly conduct.

12-Oct-17 Deputies were called to do a welfare check in the Town of Akron. Deputies made contact with the subject and upon further investigation found that the subject was in possession of a schedule 1 narcotic without a prescription. Case is under investigation.

12-Oct-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible harassment involving juveniles in the Town of Akron. The juveniles were knocking on people's doors and then running away. Deputies apprehended one of the juveniles when he was running away from the residence. He was later released to his parents and was issued a summons for harassment.
