10/27/17 through 11/03/17

27-Oct-17 Deputies were notified of a computer at the Akron Pond. The computer was stripped. Case is under investigation.

27-Oct-17 An Akron resident turned in a Razor type scooter they found in the 400 block of Elm St. in the Town of Akron. Deputies placed photos on the Sheriff's Office Facebook page of the scooter. The scooter has not been claimed.

27-Oct-17 Deputies were dispatched to a call about stolen medication. After investigation Gyna Jesse was arrested for possession of a controlled substance and theft of medication. The medication was returned to the owner and Jesse was transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Jesse was later released on a \$5000.00 PR bond.

28-Oct-17 Deputies were called to East Morgan County Hospital on a dog bite victim. When deputies arrived the victim had been treated for facial wounds. The owner of the dog was contacted and the dog was quarantined for 10 days.

28-Oct-17 Deputies responded to a medical in the 700 block of Grand Ave. When deputies arrived the male was deceased. The coroner took over the scene.

30-Oct-17 Deputies received a report of a possible dog poisoning in the Town of Akron. The owner was advised to take the dogs to the vet. The owner discovered that her dogs had eaten a rabbit and that was what was making them sick.

30-Oct-17 Deputies issued an ordinance warning in the Town of Akron for junk and weeds.

30-Oct-17 Deputies received a report that a victim's roommate had accessed his credit card accounts and was purchasing medication in his name. Case is under investigation.

30-Oct-17 Deputies received a report of an unlicensed driver in the Town of Akron. Deputies observed Saul Stilwell driving and he was issued a summons for driving without a valid driver's license.

30-Oct-17 Deputies received a call in reference to possible phone harassment in the Town of Akron. Upon investigation, deputies found no criminal intent. The parties were told to not communicate with each other.

31-Oct-17 Deputies responded to a disturbance in progress on Cedar Ave in the Town of Akron. Upon further investigation, deputies cited Dennis Mulvaney and a minor for disturbing the peace. Deputies were called back to the residence numerous times throughout the day for the same issue. Deputies eventually arrested Dennis Mulvaney on harassment charges. Mulvaney was later released after pleading guilty and was given probation.

31-Oct-17 Deputies were notified of a theft that occurred thru a PayPal account. The reporting party stated that he had three transactions in September that were not authorized. Case is under investigation.

The male party was found after several hours and taken to the East Morgan County Hospital due to being in the cold and intoxicated.
