

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

Press Release

11/03/17 through 11/10/17

03-Nov-17 Deputies were notified by the owner of a residence in the Town of Akron that someone had been cutting his property line markings which he had based the placement of his fence line. The issue is ongoing. Case is under investigation.

03-Nov-17 A FedEx employee came to the Washington County Sheriff's Office to report he had been bitten by a dog at a residence northeast of Akron. The dog was identified and quarantined at the residence.

03-Nov-17 Deputies arrested Saul Stillwell on a Washington County warrant for failure to appear. He was transported to Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$150.00 bond.

04-Nov-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance east of Hwy 63 on CO RD 50. After further investigation it was determined that no criminal activity had occurred.

04-Nov-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance in the Town of Otis. Case is under investigation.

04-Nov-17 Deputies received a report of a stolen green 1950 Pontiac Etzer. Reporting party stated the vehicle was inoperable and would have to be towed or hauled. Case is under investigation.

04-Nov-17 Deputies responded to a possible harassment in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

05-Nov-17 Deputies received a report of a missing/runaway juvenile. After a few hours the juvenile was found safe.

06-Nov-17 Deputies had a party come to the Washington County Sheriff's Office to report pills missing from their residence. Case is under investigation.

06-Nov-17 Deputies received a report from an Akron resident that a vehicle had backed out of the neighbor's driveway and stuck his fence causing minor damage. Neighbors heard the impact but did not see the vehicle or the driver. Case is under investigation.

06-Nov-17 Deputies arrested Chris Morris, when he turned himself in at the Washington County Justice Center. Morris had two warrants out of Washington County Courts for failure to appear. Morris was later released on a \$500.00 bond and a \$1500.00 bond.

07-Nov-17 Deputies received a report of multiple car batteries being stolen. Case is under investigation.

08-Nov-17 Deputies received a report of a loose dog in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the Akron Pound and the owner was later located. The owner was given verbal warning for dog at large.

08-Nov-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible dangerous dog. The dog was located and taken to the veterinarian due to injuries. The dog was later euthanized due to serious injuries that dog had received from other animals.

08-Nov-17 While deputies were conducting a VIN inspection at the Washington County Sheriff's Office they discovered that the plates did not belong to the vehicle. The plates were seized.

08-Nov-17 Deputies received a call about a syringe that was found at the Akron City Park. Several juveniles were playing at the park when they found the syringe. Case is under investigation.

08-Nov-17 Deputies were dispatched to Otis with regard to drug activity. Upon arrival, deputies discovered a disturbance involving the resident and her family due to the alleged drug activity. While on scene deputies arrested Kelsey Mann on a warrant out of Weld County Court. Mann was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$1000.00 bond.

10-Nov-17 Deputies received a report of a stolen bicycle in the Town of Akron. The bicycle was later located.

10-Nov-17 While in custody, deputies arrested Jacob Rudman on a warrant out of Jefferson County. Rudman is being held on a \$5000.00 bond.

10-Nov-17 Deputies received a report of shots fired near CO RD UU and CO RD 41. Upon arrival deputies found evidence but do not have any suspect(s) at this time. Case is under investigation.
