

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

Press Release

06/09/17 through 06/16/17

09-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible trespass in the Town of Akron. The female party was advised she was not welcome on the property at the owner's request. The female party was given a warning and was told to leave.

09-Jun-17 While on a traffic stop, Phillip Wolters was arrested on failure to appear warrant out of Washington County Courts. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$350.00 bond.

10-Jun-17 Deputies received a report that two bucket calves had left a barn/corral area north of Lindon on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, and efforts to find them have been unsuccessful. They are believed to have been stolen. Both calves bear a Lazy 3 brand with a cross below that on the left hip. Both are black steers, one with a brockled face. Case is under investigation.

10-Jun-17 Deputies received a call from a resident of a local nursing home reporting that a variety of coins were stolen from his former residence before the home was purchased by the current owner. He described the coins as a variety of pennies and silver dollars, including Morgan dollars and Presidential dollars. Case is under investigation.

11-Jun-17 William Colvin III was arrested after being reported as a suspicious party near the Cornerstone Café. He was found to be in possession of marijuana in violation of a protection order issued by Morgan County Court. He is being held pending advisement.

12-Jun-17 Dylan Kreiling turned himself in pursuant to an arrest warrant issued by Washington County Courts. He was later released on a \$150.00 bond.

12-Jun-17 Omar Fierro was arrested in Morgan County on a Washington County warrant. He was transported to Washington County Justice Center and is being held on a \$7500.00 bond.

12-Jun-17 While investigating a possible theft in the Town of Akron, deputies arrested Charlene Holoman on a Denver County warrant for failure to appear. She was transported to the Washington County Justice Center. She was later transported to Denver City Jail. Deputies also issued summons to two parties one for possession or consumption of alcohol by a minor and the second for buying alcohol for the minor.

13-Jun-17 While deputies were conducting property checks at the Akron Pond they made contact with a party who was identified as Justin Horinek had a warrant for failure to appear. He was later released on a \$10000.00 bond.

15-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a call about stolen oil. Upon arrival at CO RD 21 & CO RD P it was discovered that approximately 70 barrels of oil had been taken from a tank without authorization from the owner. Case is under investigation.
