

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

Press Release

05/26/17 through 06/02/17

26-May-17 Deputies received a call about a dog running around south east of Akron unsupervised. The owner was given a warning for dog at large.

26-May-17 During a routine traffic stop deputies cited Braden Brent for operating an uninsured motor vehicle on an open roadway, failure to display valid registration & failure to provide a child restraint 4-7 yoa.

26-May-17 Deputies observed a vehicle with its hazards lights on behind Farmers State Bank on 1<sup>st</sup> & Main. Deputies observed a male party was on the sidewalk laying on his back. The male party had laid his motorcycle over due to wet pavement and gravel on the roadway. The Washington County Ambulance checked the male party and released him.

28-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible fraud case. Upon further investigation it was determined that the victim had received an email disguised as a creditor. The email stated the victim had possible fraudulent activity and requested her personal information. This case is under investigation.

29-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible animal cruelty in the 60 block of Cedar in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival, deputies observed several rabbit cages with rabbits in them. One of the rabbits was dead. The other rabbits had no food or water. Roselyn Murray was issued a summons for Cruelty to Animals.

30-May-17 Deputies issued several ordinance violations in the Town of Akron for overgrown weeds.

30-May-17 While in custody, Christopher Martinez was arrested on a warrant out of Arapahoe County District Court. He is being held on a \$50,000.00 bond. Mr. Martinez also has a hold placed on him from the Colorado Dept. of Corrections. There is no bond associated with this hold.

30-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a burglary in the Town of Otis. After further investigation it was determined that a laptop had been stolen. Case is under investigation.

30-May-17 Deputies stopped a vehicle for failing to drive in a single lane. Upon further investigation, it was determined that Rose Clanton was driving under the influence of Alcohol/Drugs or both. Ms. Clanton was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center where she was charged with DUID, and failing to drive in a single lane/weaving. She was later released on a \$2000.00 cash/surety bond.

31-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a complaint about a stray black cat. Deputies caught the cat and took it to the Akron Pound. Owner has not claimed the cat.

31-May-17 Deputies stopped a vehicle for failure to display current registration on a motor vehicle. Upon contact with the driver it was determined that the driver, Richard Tharp was under in the influence of alcohol. Mr. Tharp was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center on charges of DUI, Operating aa uninsured motor vehicle on a public roadway, and failed to display valid registration. He was later released on a summons.

30-May-17 Deputies responded to a dog bite in the Town of Otis. The dog bite victim was taken to the hospital where he received stitches. The victim's family did not wish to press charges. The dog is on home quarantine.

01-Jun-17 Deputies arrested Gary Garcia after he came to visit an inmate. After a routine inquiry revealed a protection order in which Mr. Garcia was restrained from contacting the person whom he had

accompanied to Washington County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Garcia is being held pending advisement.

01-Jun-17 Deputies arrested Kelsey Mann on a warrant out of Logan County for failure to appear. Ms. Mann is being held on a \$1000.00 bond.
