12-May-17 Deputies received a report of a recovered cell phone found at Prewitt Reservoir. The owner of the phone was contacted and later picked up the cell phone.

13-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible burglary in the Town of Otis. Upon arrival it was determined that someone had entered a shed adjacent to a garage on the south side of Otis. The suspect(s) took hand tools and rechargeable batteries for power tools. This case is under investigation.

13-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance in the Town of Otis. Upon further investigation, Seth Winkler was arrested on charges of Disorderly Conduct & False Imprisonment. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on \$1000.00 bond.

13-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance in the Messex area. Upon further investigation, Danielle Brunn was arrested on charges of Criminal Mischief. She was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$750.00 bond.

14-May-17 While investigating a possible harassment at a residence in the Town of Akron, deputies noticed unsafe living conditions of the house. Deputies later contacted DHS and the mother was issued a summons for Child Abuse.

14-May-17 An Akron resident reported that his dog was stolen from a locked yard between May 11th & May 14th, 2017. The dog is a male Great Dane gray in color. Case is under investigation.

15-May-17 Deputies received a report that unknown suspect(s) climbed on duct work on the east side of the Akron School in an attempt to gain access to the roof causing an estimated \$1000.00 in damage to the duct work. Case is under investigation.

15-May-17 While in custody, Gregory Christenson was arrested on a warrant out of Arapahoe County. He is being held on a \$1000.00 bond.

17-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible juvenile runaway in the 600 block of 4th Ave. When deputies arrived on scene the juvenile was back at the residence.

18-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible stabbing in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival it was determined that the resident had been stabbed. The juvenile suspect had left the scene and was later located and taken into custody. The juvenile was later transported to Platte Valley Youth Center and charged with Assault with a deadly weapon. The juvenile will be held pending advisement.
