06/16/17 through 06/23/17

- 16-Jun-17 Deputies issued several ordinance violations in the Town of Otis and the Town of Akron.
- 18-Jun-17 During a routine traffic stop, deputies arrested Daniel White driving under revocation. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$500.00 surety bond.
- 18-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a traffic accident in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival it was determined that the juvenile driver had struck a parked vehicle belonging to Travyn Musgrave. The juvenile driver was cited for improper turn at an intersection.
- 19-Jun-17 An Akron resident reported that his debit card number had been used in Walsenburg and all the money from the account had been taken. Case is under investigation.
- 19-Jun-17 Deputies received a report of two motorcycles weaving in and out of traffic and passing vehicles in an unsafe manner. Maurita and Thomas Churchill were contacted and cited for passing on left when prohibited by signs and markings.
- 19-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a vehicle roll over on CO RD Q at the railroad crossing. The suspect was observed running from the vehicle. The suspect was apprehended by deputies and the Colorado State Patrol troopers.
- 19-Jun-17 Deputies responded to a traffic accident in the Family Dollar parking lot. Kayla Headden was backing out of the parking spot when she struck a vehicle belonging to Betty Schropfer. Mrs. Headden was cited for limitations on backing.

- 20-Jun-17 Deputies received a complaint about a dog at large on 1<sup>st</sup> & Cedar in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the Akron pound. The owner, Mariah Christensen later picked up the dog. Ms. Christensen was given a verbal warning for dog at large.
- 21-Jun-17 During a routine traffic stop, deputies discovered that the driver, Joseph Manalang was driving without a driver's license. The driver was cited for driving without a valid driver's license.
- 22-Jun-17 Deputies received a call about a dog at large near 1<sup>st</sup> & Fir Ave. Deputies took the dog to the Akron Pound. The owner, Harry Holmsten later picked up the dog. Mr. Holmsten was given a verbal warning for dog at large.
