

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

Press Release

06/23/17 through 06/30/17

24-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a report of a vehicle being stolen from a residence south of Akron, and believed to be headed north on Hwy 63. While enroute to attempt to find the vehicle, a Colorado State Patrol trooper spotted the vehicle and pulled behind it. Deputies and Colorado State Patrol troopers were able to take the suspect into custody without incident and recovered the vehicle for the victim. The suspect later identified as Zachary Wells, was arrested and charged with 1<sup>st</sup> degree burglary, Theft, and Criminal Mischief. Mr. Wells was transported to the Washington County Justice Center where he is being held on a \$10000.00 bond.

25-Jun-17 Deputies received a call about a verbal argument at Anton Supers. Deputies talked to the reporting party and gave her options of what to do if it happened again.

25-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible unattended death. Upon arrival it was determined that party was deceased. The coroner took over the scene.

25-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a dog at large in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival it was determined that a black dog was being aggressive and fighting with other dogs. The owner of the dog, Kelly Bonnell was given a warning for dog at large.

26-Jun-17 Deputies received a report from an Akron resident about an attempted fraud from Publisher's Clearing House. Case is under investigation. Residents are urged not to deposit checks from unknown sources, and contact the Sheriff's Office with any concerns or questions when they receive these materials.

26-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival, it was determined it was a verbal argument with a person trespassing at the residence. The person trespassing was contacted and told not to return to the residence.

26-Jun-17 Deputies were dispatched to the campgrounds at Prewitt Reservoir for a naked man that was highly intoxicated. Upon arrival deputies observed a male party sitting in his vehicle naked. Deputies arrested Erie Dyer on charges of Public Indecency and DUI. Mr. Dyer was transported to the Washington County Justice Center. He was later released on a \$2000.00 bond.

27-Jun-17 While in custody, Ryan Potter was arrested on a warrant out of Weld County. He is being held on a \$2000.00 bond.

27-Jun-17 Deputies received a report of a vehicle being abandoned in front of a residence in Akron. Deputies will be contacting the owner of the vehicle to get the vehicle removed.

27-Jun-17 Deputies received a report of a stray dog in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the Akron pound. The owner, Jordan Vick, later picked up the dog and was given a verbal warning for dog at large.

27-Jun-17 During a traffic stop, deputies arrested Maurico Herrera Balderas for driving with no valid driver's license and providing false information to deputies. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center. He was later released on a surety bond.

28-Jun-17 While in custody, Duane Poage was arrested for protection order violation. He is being held pending advisement by a judge.

29-Jun-17 Deputies issued several ordinance violations in the Town of Otis for overgrown weeds and

accumulation of junk.

29-Jun-17 Deputies received a report from an Akron resident of harassment. Deputies contacted the resident and gave her options as to what to do.

29-Jun-17 While in custody, Zachary Wells was arrested on a warrant out of Washington County Courts for probation violation. He is being held on a \$1000.00 bond.

29-Jun-17 Amanda Vega-Crespin was arrested on two warrants out of Adams County District Court. The warrants were discovered during a routine records check when Mrs. Vega-Crespin came to the Washington County Sheriff's Office to pick up an inmate who was being released. Mrs. Vega-Crespin was later released on \$1002.00 bond.
