06/30/17 through 07/07/17

30-Jun-17 Deputies were contacted by a juvenile female who walked up to the Sheriff's Office doors. There was a male party that was following her who had self-inflicted wounds to both forearms and was in possession of drug paraphernalia. The male party later identified as Benjamin Clawson was checked out by Washington County Ambulance Service and after being cleared by medical personnel he was arrested. He was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia, and harassment. He was later released on a \$1500.00 surety bond.

01-Jul-17 While in custody, Nickolas Haan was arrested on a warrant out of Adams County. He is being held on a \$20,000.00 bond.

04-Jul-17 Deputies were dispatched to a dog at large in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival, the two dogs were taken to the Akron Pound. The dogs were later claimed by the owner, Richard Burnett. Mr. Burnett was given a warning for dogs at large.

04-Jul-17 During a traffic stop, deputies cited Norman Bjork for failing to dim lamps when required and driving a motor vehicle when license is under restraint.

06-Jul-17 Deputies issued a summons to James Clark for having five unlicensed dogs and being in violation of his variance to have more than three dogs in town after he was given a verbal warning.

05-Jul-17 Deputies were dispatched to the Akron City Park for a possible dispute in progress. Deputies made contact with both parties. Both parties were arrested and taken to the Washington County Justice Center for further questioning. After the investigation was complete, the female party was released. The male party, James Abeyta was arrested and booked into Washington County Justice Center on charges of 3 degree assault. He is being held pending advisement.

05-Jul-17 While in custody, James Abeyta was issued a summons for theft and trespassing.

06-Jul-17 Deputies were contacted by an individual who had picked up a dog running around in the Town of Akron and brought it to the Washington County Sheriff's Office. The dog was later claimed by the owner, Rachelle Lage. Mrs. Lage was given a warning for dog at large.
