01/27/17 through 02/03/17

27-Jan-17 A juvenile resident from Akron reported that cash and candy bars were stolen from her residence. The theft occurred during the early morning hours of 01/27/2017. This case is under investigation.

27-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to a call about a Knaack jobsite toolbox and a Ridgid toolbox, apparently being towed on a car dolly. The toolboxes became dislodged from the dolly and fell off. The toolboxes and car dolly were abandoned on the shoulder of Hwy 63 just south of Milepost 9. The toolboxes and dolly are being held at the Washington County Sheriff's Office pending identification of, and return to, the rightful owner.

27-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched on a possible parking complaint/traffic accident. The resident was unable to move from her parking place and was uncertain whether the offending vehicle stuck hers. Deputies determined that no accident had occurred and the resident requested that the offending vehicle/driver cited for the parking violation. Jon Etl was cited for Improper stopping, standing or parking in specified places.

28-Jan-17 Deputies responded to a cold trespass located in the 300 block of North Railroad in the Town of Otis. Upon further investigation the property owner advised there was no property taken just a deadbolt had been cut. Case is under investigation.

29-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to the 500 block of W 2nd St in Akron in reference to a theft of a car winch. After further investigation it was determined that a winch, battery and battery box were taken. Case is under investigation.

29-Jan-17 Deputies initiated a traffic stop at 1st St & Fir Ave. as a vehicle had crossed the center dividing line, nearly going head on with a deputy. Upon further investigation, Alicia Bergling was taken into custody for driving under revocation. Also while investigating; narcotics paraphernalia was located in the vehicle as well as narcotics being located on Ms. Berglings person. Ms. Bergling was transported to the Washington County Sheriff's Office on charges of Driving when license revoked, failed to maintain single lane (weaving), possession of a controlled substance schedule II and introduction of contraband into a detention facility. She is being held on \$5000.00 bond.

30-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to the 400 block of Birch Ave. in Akron in reference to a vandalism. Upon further investigation it was found that three windows had been shot out using what appeared to be a BB or pellet gun. Case is under investigation.

30-Jan-17 Deputies received a report of a dog bite in the Town of Otis. Dog was placed in a 10 day home quarantine and victim was treated at the hospital for her injuries.

30-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to a residential fire in the 600 block of W 11th Ave in the town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

31-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to a theft in the 26000 block of CO RD 45. Upon further investigation, it was determined that a small Chibi/Rockford motorcycle and a small 4X5 trailer had been stolen from the property. Case is under investigation.

02-Feb-17 Deputies arrested Tammy Phillips in Otis on a warrant out of Logan County District Court. She is being held with no bond pending transport to Logan County.
