12-Jan-18 While in custody, deputies arrested Neil Hawkinson on a warrant out of Washington County for failure to comply with bond conditions. Hawkinson is being held on a \$4000.00 bond.

12-Jan-18 Deputies received a call about a possible harassment that involved juveniles in the Akron area. Case is under investigation.
