05/11/18 through 05/18/18

- 11-May-18 Deputies observed an accumulation of weeds in the Town of Akron. Deputies issued a notice to have the weeds trimmed.
- 11-May-18 Deputies received a call about a dog at large in the 400 block of Delta. The dog was taken to the Akron pound. The dog's owner later came to get the dog and was given a verbal warning for dog at large.
- 11-May-18 Deputies were called to Hwy 34 and CO RD GG on a deer that had been hit but was still alive. The deputies later put the animal down.
- 11-May-18 Deputies found a dog running in and out of traffic on Hwy 34 and CO RD GG. The dog was taken to the Akron Pound. The dog's owner was later found and given a verbal warning for dog at large.
- 12-May-18 Deputies received a report of a possible domestic dispute in the Town of Akron. After arrival and investigation, Jason Collins was arrested for harassment and domestic violence. Collins was later released on a PR bond.
