05/18/18 through 05/25/18

18-May-18 Deputies responded to a disturbance in the 400 block of Elm Ave in the Town of Akron. The reporting party also stated that a domestic disturbance had occurred. There was not enough evidence to substantiate a charge for domestic violence.

18-May-18 Deputies received a report from Human Services about a juvenile female receiving inappropriate communications with an older male through Facebook Messenger. Case is under investigation.

19-May-18 Deputies responded to a single car accident on Hwy 71 near mile marker 138. Colorado State Patrol took over the scene.

19-May-18 Deputies found a gray Mongoose bicycle at the Roadside Park in the Town of Akron. The bicycle was taken to the Washington County Sheriff's Office until the owner can be found.

21-May-18 Deputies found two stray kittens in the southwest part of Akron. The cats were taken to the Akron pound and later transported to the humane society so they could be adopted.

21-May-18 Deputies received a call of a vehicle pulling a trailer with miscellaneous items falling off the trailer into traffic. The items hit a windshield and broke it. The case was turned over to Colorado State Patrol as this had happened in another jurisdiction.

22-May-18 Deputies were dispatched to a cat bite in Washington County. The cat was up to date on all shots. The cat was put on a 10 day home quarantine.

22-May-18 Deputies received a call about a possible theft of electricity. Deputies observed that the meter had been tampered with. Case is under investigation.

22-May-18 While in custody, Nicholas Mastin was arrested on a warrant out of Garfield County District Court. Mastin is being held on a \$2500.00 bond.
