06/01/18 through 06/08/18

01-Jun-18 Deputies were dispatched to a minor traffic accident at Davis Bros in the Town of Akron. Tyrell McCord was issued a citation for limitations on backing.

02-Jun-18 While in custody, David Smith was arrested on a warrant out of Mesa County for felony escape and forgery. Smith is being held without bond.

02-Jun-18 Deputies arrested Jeremy Stallings on a warrant out of Eagle County for failure to appear. He was later released on a \$5000.00 bond.
