06/15/18 through 06/22/18

- 15-Jun-18 Deputies received a call from property owner in the Town of Otis about several chickens that were decapitated in their coop and several others were missing. Case is under investigation.
- 15-Jun-18 Fred Thornton turned himself in on a warrant out of Akron Municipal Court. Thornton was later released on a \$50.00 bond.
- 16-Jun-18 Deputies responded to a semi stuck on the railroad tracks at approximately Hwy 34 & CO RD EE. Upon arrival the semi had already been cleared from the railroad tracks. CSP assisted with the crash and the Akron Volunteer Fire Dept. assisted with the diesel cleanup.
- 17-Jun-18 Deputies responded to a possible animal neglect on CO RD GG. Case is under investigation.
