06/22/18 through 06/29/18

- 22-Jun-18 Deputies were dispatched to a trespassing at a residence in the Town of Akron. After arriving on scene deputies found the home owner and a friend had held the trespasser on scene. After further investigation it was determined that no charges would be filed.
- 22-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of a stolen vehicle in Washington County. The vehicle was later found in Yuma County and later returned to the owner. Case is under investigation.
- 22-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of a trespass and criminal mischief on CO RD 22 & CO RD TT. Case is under investigation.
- 23-Jun-18 Deputies conducted a traffic stop in the Town of Akron. During the stop it was determined that the driver, Chasity Jacobs had a warrant and was arrested. Jacobs was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$50.00 bond.
- 23-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of two parties being bitten by a dog in the 200 block of S. Vine in the Town of Otis. The dogs got away from the parties and have not been located.
- 24-Jun-18 Deputies responded to a vehicle accident at 1st & Custer in the Town of Akron. Upon investigation a male juvenile was arrested on a DUI. The juvenile was later cited and released to his parents.

Deputies were also advised that the boxer was aggressive. Deputies were unable to locate the animals and the case is under investigation.
