06/29/18 through 07/06/18

- 29-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of a possible trespass and theft in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.
- 29-Jun-18 Deputies were dispatched to a vehicle fire at the USDA Research Facility. After investigation, it appeared the fire was caused by dry vegetation in the vehicles undercarriage. The fire was extinguished with minor damage to the vehicle.
- 29-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of a dog at large in the 600 block of Fremont Ave in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the pound and the owner, Tyler McMullen later came to pick up the dog and was given a warning for dog at large.
- 29-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of criminal mischief at approximately Railroad and Hickory in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.
- 29-Jun-18 Deputies received a report of a hit and run accident at the Akron Post Office. Case is under investigation.

A search warrant was executed at the residence and the counterfeit money was seized. The marijuana appeared to be a legal quantity and was left at the residence.

- 01-Jul-18 Deputies assisted Division of Wildlife with a possible protection order violation at the Prewitt Reservoir.
