- 13-Jul-18 Deputies took a report of a suicidal party in the lobby at the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Upon talking with the individual they were voluntarily transported to a local hospital.
- 13-Jul-18 Deputies received a report of insurance fraud in the Town of Otis. While investigating the report deputies were told that the roofing company sent paperwork to the insurance company saying the roof was repaired when the roof was never repaired. Case is under investigation.
- 13-Jul-18 Deputies received a report of possible child abuse in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.
- 15-Jul-18 Deputies received a call about a possible harassment in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.
- 15-Jul-18 Deputies received a call about a possible harassment in the Town of Lindon. Case is under investigation.

Deputies was advised that the accident involved a pilot car and a prisoner transport which was carrying 9 prisoners. 7 of the prisoners had minor injuries and were transported to local hospitals for treatment. 2 of the prisoners were transported to Washington County Justice Center. Colorado State Patrol took over the scene.
- 17-Jul-18 Deputies were notified of a lost birth certificate and social security card in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.
- 19-Jul-18 Deputies made a traffic contact with a party believed to be driving without a license. Vanessa Loomis was arrested on an active warrant out of Nebraska. Loomis is being held without bond.
- 19-Jul-18 While in custody, John Ramos was arrested on a warrant. Ramos was later released on bond.
