08/03/18 through 08/10/18

03-Aug-18 Deputies received a call from a resident in the Town of Otis on a theft. When deputies arrived the resident reported her lawn mower had been stolen. The lawn mower was later located and returned to the resident. No charges were filed.

05-Aug-18 Deputies received a report of a dog bite at the East Morgan County Hospital. The individual received stitches and the dog was put on a 10 day home quarantine. No charges were filed.

06-Aug-18 Deputies received a report of a possible theft of camping equipment at Prewitt Reservoir. Upon arrival deputies contacted the reporting party about the stolen camping equipment. Numerous items were taken from the individual's camp. Case is under investigation.

07-Aug-18 Deputies responded to a residence in the Town of Akron on a report of trespassing. It was determined that no one was trespassing and it was a mental health issue. The party was transported to the hospital for a mental health evaluation.
