Press Release

09/07/18 through 09/14/2018

- 07-Sept-18 Deputies were notified of a possible burglary that occurred in the Akron area. Case is under investigation.
- 07-Sept-18 While in custody, Brent Christy was arrested on a warrant out of Aurora Police Dept. for failure to appear. Christy was later transported to Arapahoe County.
- 07-Sept-18 Deputies were notified of loose goats in a parking lot on the east side of Akron. Deputies with the help of a local resident corralled the goats until the owner could claim them.
- 08-Sept-18 Deputies were dispatched to a report of a gas leak in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival, deputies discovered that a gas line had been struck by a lawn mower. Black Hills arrived on scene and fixed the leak. There were no charges filed.
- 08-Sept-18 Deputies received a report of methamphetamines found in a residence in the Town of Akron. Deputies collected the methamphetamines and brought them to the Sheriff's Office to be destroyed. Case is under investigation.
- 08-Sept-18 Deputies were dispatched to a verbal disturbance in the 300 block of Cedar. Deputies arrived on scene and spoke with the reporting party. She stated that her and her husband had a verbal argument and that her husband had left and had been drinking. The husband was later contacted. No charges were filed.
- 09-Sept-18 Deputies received a report of a fraud incident concerning food stamp wages. Case is under investigation.
- 10-Sept-18 Deputies received a report from the Akron Schools about a bottle of multiple oxycodone and tizanidine found on the playground. Case is under investigation.
- 10-Sept-18 Deputies responded to a one vehicle crash on Hwy 61 at approx. CO RD 45. Upon arrival, deputies found two parties involved in the accident. The passenger of the vehicle was transported to a nearby hospital, the driver was pronounced dead on scene. Colorado State Patrol took over the crash.
- 10-Sept-18 Deputies received a report of a combine south of Akron. The Akron Volunteer Fire Dept. was able to extinguish the fire. During the investigation it was found that the owner of the property had been attempting to fix the combine by welding a new part on to the combine. While welding a spark is believed to have caused the fire. No charges were filed.
- 12-Sept-18 While in custody, Carrie Smith was arrested on a warrant out of Washington County Courts. Smith was later released on a \$500.00 bond.

12-Sept-18 A resident of Kansas, engaged in a divorce action with a Washington County resident, reported that fraudulent documents were filed with the court in Kansas, and he believes those documents were fabricated in Washington County. Case is under investigation.

12-Sept-18 While initiating a traffic stop after it was called in as an erratic driver; deputies found that the driver of the vehicle was revoked. The driver, Lonnie Cole was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Cole was charged with driving vehicle when license under restraint (Revoked Refusal). Cole was later released on a \$500.00 bond.

14-Sept-18 While in custody, Kimberly Deems was arrested on a warrant out of Denver District Court. Deems is being held without bond pending advisement.

14-Sept-18 Deputies received a report of possible child abuse. The matter was investigated and it was determined that no criminal action had taken place. The case was forwarded to the Department of Social Services.
