

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

09/14/18 through 09/21/18

14-Sep-18 While in custody, Michael Plumb was arrested on a warrant out of Colorado Department of Corrections Fugitive Extradition Unit. Plumb is being held without bond.

16-Sep-18 Deputies were dispatched to a one vehicle rollover on CR 39 & CR WW. The driver was pronounced dead at the scene and Colorado State Patrol took over the scene.

17-Sep-18 While in custody, David Boltjes was arrested on a warrant out of Adams County District Court. Boltjes is being held on a \$2500.00 bond.
