09/28/18 through 10/05/18

28-Sep-18 Deputies responded to a call of two dogs that attacked another dog. The dog that was attacked was in its yard when the attack occurred. Deputies attempted to locate the dogs but were unsuccessful at the time. Later deputies responded to a call from another party in which their dog was being attacked by the same two dogs. The party was able to identify the dogs that were involved in the attack. Ashlee Hernandez was issued a summons for unlawful possession of a dangerous dog x2. The dogs are being held at the Akron Pound on 10 day quarantine.

28-Sep-18 Deputies received a call from Akron residents on a report of almost being victims of the "Grandparents Scam". They had received a call from someone purported to be their grandson, in a hospital in Georgia, and about to be arrested after a traffic accident. They were asked for several thousand dollars in bail money in cash, which they sent by overnight mail. They were able to intercept the money before it was sent in the mail. This is a common scam and residents are urged not to respond. Consult with your local law enforcement for guidance and assistance before considering sending funds in response to such a call.

28-Sep-18 After being contacted for speeding, Ariel Allen was arrested on charges of DUI, speeding, failing to present evidence of insurance, child abuse, and fugitive from justice. Allen is being held on a \$1500.00 bond. Allen also has a no bond warrant out of Texas.

28-Sep-18 Deputies received a call about a dog being found on CO RD Y at approx. CO RD 47. Due to the adverse weather and the dog being unable to fend for himself, deputies took the dog to the Akron Pound. The owner was later located and paid impound fees and given a verbal warning for dog at large.

29-Sep-18 Deputies received a report of a family disturbance in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival the juvenile was told the consequences if the behavior continues. No charges were filed at this time.

29-Sep-18 Deputies responded to the Bank of Colorado for a report of multiple counterfeit bills that had been passed. Case is under investigation.

30-Sep-18 Deputies received a report of a dog that ran out from behind a car and into the street running into a bicyclist causing the bicyclist to fall off his bicycle. There was minor damage to the bicycle as well as the bicyclist. No charges were filed at this time.

30-Sep-18 Deputies responded to a disturbance in the Town of Akron. Jan Rodriguez Jimenez was arrested on criminal mischief and domestic violence. Rodriguez Jimenez was later released on a \$1000.00 bond.

01-Oct-18 Deputies responded to a residence in the Town of Akron. The party was hearing voices and cutting themselves. The party was referred to Centennial Mental Health.

02-Oct-18 Deputies responded to a domestic violence call in the Arickaree area. When deputies arrived the caller denied making the call, and there were no obvious injuries. Deputies were unable to substantiate the complaint.
