Press Release

10/12/18 through 10/19/18

12-Oct-18 Deputies were dispatched to a possible domestic dispute in which a female was dropped off west of Akron. Deputies determined that no crime had taken place and the parties were cautioned about the consequences of their behavior.

14-Oct-18 Deputies responded to a disturbance in the 400 block of Elm Ave. Upon further investigation, deputies determined that the two parties were just having a verbal argument and no charges were filed.

14-Oct-18 Deputies assisted Division of Wildlife with their investigation of a wild animal being kept as a pet in the Town of Akron. Division of Wildlife took over the scene

14-Oct-18 Deputies took a report of a dog bite in the Town of Akron. The victim did not wish to press charges and the dog was put on a 10 day home quarantine.
