11/01/18 through 11/09/18

01-Nov-18 While in custody, Baruc Reyes-Rodriguez was arrested on warrant for failure to appear. Reyes-Rodriguez is being held on a \$250.00 bond.

01-Nov-18 While in custody, Hardrick Smith was arrested on a warrant out of Aurora. Smith is being held on a \$500.00 bond.

02-Nov-18 While in custody, William Ralph was arrested on a warrant out of Washington County for failure to appear. Ralph was later released on a \$1000.00 bond.

03-Nov-18 While in custody, Christopher Patterson was arrested on a warrant from Sterling Police Department. Patterson is being held on a \$20,000.00 bond.

05-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of a runaway juvenile. The juvenile was later located with her boyfriend. The juvenile was placed in temporary care until her parent(s) could come and pick her up.

05-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of harassment in the Town of Akron. All parties were contacted and given verbal warnings. No charges were filed at this time.

06-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a reckless driving complaint in the Town of Otis. After searching for the vehicle deputies cleared the scene as they were unable to locate the vehicle.

06-Nov-18 Deputies arrested Justin Horinek on a warrant out of Washington County. Horinek was later released on a \$250.00 bond.

06-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a civil dispute north of the fairgrounds. Deputies contacted the suspect vehicle after it left the scene. When deputies approached the vehicle the driver, Jeremy Lohman fled the scene and the juvenile passenger was detained. Deputies searched for Lohman for several hours but were unable to locate him. Lohman was later arrested in Nebraska on multiple warrants out of Colorado and Nebraska.

06-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of a suicidal party that had been involved in an altercation. All parties involved were evaluated and no charges were filed.

06-Nov-18 Deputies responded to a disturbance in the Town of Akron. After arriving on scene deputies determined that it was just siblings fighting. No charges were filed.

08-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of unknown suspect(s) attempting to obtain gasoline from vehicles parking the Town of Otis. This occurred during November 2nd and November 6th. Case is under investigation.

07-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a single vehicle accident located in the Town of Akron. There were no injuries reported and the vehicle sustained minor damage. The minor juvenile was issued a citation for speed too fast for conditions/special hazards.
