

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

Press Release

11/09/18 through 11/16/18

09-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of a series of thefts and vandalism to a farming operation south of Akron. Case is under investigation.

10-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of a possible harassment in the Town of Akron. Deputies spoke with both parties involved. No charges were filed at this time.

11-Nov-18 While deputies were patrolling the Otis area they observed a party enter the TBK Bank via the back door after business hours. After further investigation it was determined that the party was allowed to be in the building to clean.

12-Nov-18 Deputies assisted Log Lane Village Marshals with runaway juveniles that were thought to be in the Akron area. The juveniles were located at a residence in the Town of Akron and were returned to their guardians.

12-Nov-18 Deputies assisted Wiggins Police Department in locating the owner of a vehicle that was abandoned in their jurisdiction. The owner was located in Washington County and made arrangements to pick up the vehicle the following day.

13-Nov-18 While in custody, Anthony Strock was arrested on a warrant out of Adams County for failure to appear. Strock is being held on a \$750.00 bond.

13-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a minor traffic accident on East Railroad and Elm Ave in the Town of Akron. Francis White was issued a summons for careless driving.

14-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a building in downtown Otis for an odor investigation. The resident had a heavy duty heater inside the building creating a potential carbon monoxide hazard.

14-Nov-18 Deputies arrested a juvenile female on a warrant out of Washington County District Court for failure to comply. The juvenile was transported to Platte Valley Youth Center and is being held without bond.

14-Nov-18 While in custody, Edwin Smith was arrested on a warrant out of Washington County District Court. Smith is being held on a \$5,000.00 bond.

14-Nov-18 Deputies arrested Frederick Thornton on an Akron municipal warrant for failure to appear. Thornton was later released on a \$100.00 bond.

14-Nov-18 Deputies arrested Colby Dickson on two warrants. Dickson had a warrant from Sterling Police Department for failure to comply and a warrant out of Morgan County for failure to comply. Both warrants have no bond.
