17-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a report of criminal mischief and attempted burglary at the Akron Laundromat. The case is under investigation.

19-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of a fight between two juveniles at the Akron School. Deputies decided to let the parents of the juveniles discipline the juveniles. No charges were filed at this time.

20-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to a vehicle fire in the Town of Otis. Upon arrival a Ford pickup was fully engulfed and the Otis Volunteer Fire Department was on scene extinguishing the fire. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

20-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to the 53000 block of Hwy 61 on a possible suicidal party. Upon arrival, Steven Winkler was arrested on charges of Criminal Mischief and Domestic Violence. Winkler was later released on a \$2500.00 bond.

21-Nov-18 Deputies received a report of a stray male black and white tabby cat that was found on S. Elm Ave in the Town of Akron. The cat was taken to the Akron Pound in an attempt to locate the owner.

22-Nov-18 Deputies were dispatched to an unattended death on CO RD 39 in Washington County. The coroner took over the scene.

23-Nov-18 While patrolling the Town of Akron, deputies attempted to contact some juveniles at the Akron City Park. The juveniles ran when the deputies attempted to contact them. All the juveniles were later contacted and advised the park closes at 2200 hours. No charges were filed.
