30-Dec-18 Deputies were dispatched to a possible prowler in the Messex area. Deputies searched the area and were unable to locate anyone.

30-Dec-18 Deputies stopped a blue Ford sedan for expired tags in the 400 block of Custer Ave. Upon making contact with the driver, Heather Atwood was issued a summons for operating an uninsured vehicle on a public roadway and failed to obtain registration within 60 days of purchase.

30-Dec-18 Dean Beamon turned himself in on a warrant out of Washington County for failure to appear. Beamon was later released on a \$200.00 bond.

31-Dec-18 Deputies were dispatched to a possible cardiac arrest in the 700 block of 1st St. Upon arrival they found the party was deceased. The coroner took over the scene.
