

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

12/14/18 through 12/28/18

14-Dec-18 Deputies received a report of an abandoned trailer in the roadway in the 7000 block of CO RD YY. While investigating the incident deputies contacted the trailer owner and found that the trailer and a 2006 Chevrolet pickup had been taken from the residence during the night. The vehicle was entered into the CBI as stolen. The trailer was released back to the owners.

15-Dec-18 Deputies were dispatched to a report of a theft. Upon arrival it was determined that someone had stolen some round hay bales around the 3500 block of CO RD X. Case is under investigation.

16-Dec-18 Deputies were dispatched to a report of 2 dogs at large in the 200 block of Fir. The dogs were taken to the Akron Pound. The owners, Alisha Johansson was cited for dog at large 2<sup>nd</sup> offense and Frederick Thornton was cited for dog at large 4<sup>th</sup> offense.
