02/01/19 through 02/08/19

02-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to a traffic accident in the Town of Otis. After further investigation it was determined that the driver of the vehicle had a warrant out of Morgan County. The driver, Tonya Fredelake was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Fredelake was later transported to Morgan County Jail.

03-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to a dog at large on the corner of 7th and Adams in the Town of Akron. Deputies transported the dog to the Akron Pound and the owner, Kevin Sullivan was later cited for dog at large 2nd offense.

04-Feb-19 Deputies received a report from an Akron resident that someone was using an old Colorado license plate registered to them in the Denver Metro area. As a result of it being used he was being charged for tolls on E470. The plate was entered into the system as stolen.

04-Feb-19 While in custody, deputies arrested James Frank of a felony warrant out of Arapahoe County. Frank was later released to parole.

05-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to 60 block of Cedar for a family disturbance. Deputies were unable to find that any crime had been committed.
