08-Feb-19 While interviewing a juvenile on another case, the juvenile made a claim that he and his girlfriend had an altercation in which the girlfriend slapped him across the face. Case is under investigation.

08-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to a vehicle fire in the 24000 block of Hwy 34. The fire was extinguished by the Akron Volunteer Fire Department. The fire was accidentally caused by the owner adding oil to engine while it was hot.

08-Feb-19 Deputies received information from an anonymous person about a possible insurance fraud involving a traffic accident. The information was passed on to the investigating agency.

09-Feb-19 Deputies took a report of a possible criminal mischief in the 600 block of Fremont in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

11-Feb-19 While in custody, Conner Kuhn was arrested on a warrant out of Arapahoe County District Court. Kuhn was later transported to Arapahoe County.

11-Feb-19 While in custody, Kelly Butler was arrested on a warrant out of Aurora Municipal Court. She was later transported to another facility by Parole.

12-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to a minor traffic accident in the Odell's parking lot. Mary Middlebrook was issued a citation for limitations on backing. No injuries were reported.

13-Feb-19 Deputies arrested a juvenile male after the juvenile assaulted his step brother. The juvenile was transported to Platte Valley Youth Center and later released on a \$5,000.00 PR bond.

13-Feb-19 Deputies received a report of a physical altercation and threats that were occurring in downtown Akron. Deputies checked the area and were unable to find the parties. Investigation later revealed it was a domestic violence episode in which there was a protection order violation. A warrant was issued and the party, Michael Armbrust was later arrested. He is being held on a \$3,000.00 bond.

14-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to a gas drive off at Davis Bros. Deputies got a description of the vehicle and driver but were unable to locate the vehicle. Case is under investigation.
