15-Feb-19 Deputies received a report of a possible child neglect in Washington County. Deputies forwarded the report to Department of Human Services. Case is under investigation.

16-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to a cold burglary at Ison Oil in Platner. The owner, Randy Ison stated that there was cash and checks missing from the administration building. Case is under investigation.

16-Feb-19 Deputies were dispatched to the Otis Town Park on 2 mastiff mixes at large. The reporting party said that a white Chevrolet Suburban pulled up to the park and pushed the dogs out of the vehicle and took off. The dogs were taken to the Akron Pound and flyers were placed around Akron and Otis as well as on Facebook and the Washington County Sheriff's website. The dogs will be available for adoption, February 25, 2019.
