01-Mar-19 Deputies received a report of a missing juvenile in the Town of Akron. The juvenile was later located at her grandparents' house.

03-Mar-19 Deputies received a report of a stray cat at Railroad Ave and Elm Ave. The cat was taken to the Akron Pound. Flyers were hung around the Town of Akron in an attempt to locate its owner.

03-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a cold trespass and attempted motor vehicle theft in the Town of Otis. Case is under investigation.

05-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a landlord/tenant dispute in the Town of Akron. Both parties were told it was a civil issue.

05-Mar-19 Deputies received a report of a cat that was in poor health in the 200 block of Bent Ave in the Town of Akron. Deputies took the cat to the veterinarian and the cat was later euthanized due to its poor health.

05-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to possible shots fired in the Town of Cope. Upon arrival to the area deputies contacted a party who told them that he was cleaning his gun when his dog jumped over him and somehow the trigger was pulled. The bullet went through his wall and into the neighbor's window. No injuries were reported. Joshua Draves was cited for illegal discharge of a firearm.

05-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a possible family disturbance in the Anton area. Upon arrival, deputies determined that nothing criminal had taken place.

06-Mar-19 While in custody, Jorge Cardiel-Fraga was arrested on a warrant out of Washington County on charges of attempt to influence a public servant, ID theft, forgery, criminal impersonation to gain benefit, forged vehicle certificate of title and perjury. Cardiel-Fraga is being held on a \$15,000.00 bond.

07-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a traffic accident at 2nd and Weld in the Town of Otis. Upon arrival deputies observed a maroon vehicle with heavy front end damage and a school bus on the south side of 2nd. A juvenile female was cited for careless driving.

07-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a possible family disturbance in the 400 block of 6th Ave, in the Town of Akron. Deputies spoke to both parties and determined nothing criminal had taken place. Parties were separated for the night.

07-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a suspicious vehicle on CO RD 60 and CO RD JJ. Deputies attempted to contact the owner of the vehicle but were unsuccessful. The vehicle will be towed.
