03/08/19 through 03/15/19

08-Mar-19 Deputies received a 3rd party report of a Domestic Violence which occurred in the Town of Akron. Case is under investigation.

08-Mar-19 Deputies were notified of an abandoned vehicle on Hwy 71 and CO RD 20.5. The vehicle was towed due to it blocking the road.

10-Mar-19 Deputies were notified of a pickup and a trailer that was stolen north of Hwy 6. The pickup and trailer were entered into the system as stolen. The pickup was later recovered but the trailer is still missing. Case is under investigation.

11-Mar-19 Deputies arrested David Kirby on two active Washington County warrants for failure to comply. Kirby was later released on two \$750.00 PR bonds.

09-Mar-19 Deputies received a report that during the NRA banquet an individual with a felony record won a firearm and filled out the paperwork indicating eligibility to receive the firearm. A CBI check revealed that due to the criminal record, the subject was not eligible to receive the firearm. Case is under investigation.

11-Mar-19 Deputies arrested Nicholas Duarte on a Washington County warrant for failure to appear. Duarte was later released on a \$250.00 PR bond.

11-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a suspicious incident at the Anton CO-OP. The reporting party said that there were 3 or 4 people that seemed to be arguing. When deputies arrived and contacted the parties they determined that one of the males was working on a broken axle on his trailer.

12-Mar-19 Deputies responded to an animal at large in the 300 block of Adams Ave. The cat was later taken to the Akron Pound. Flyers were hung up around town to try and find the owner.

12-Mar-19 Deputies received a complaint from an Otis resident about vehicles parked on his property. The property is posted with "No Trespassing" signs. A warning notice was placed on the offender's vehicle.

Area residents are reminded that a property owner may have vehicles towed off his/her property at the expense of the vehicle owner if vehicles are left there without consent.

12-Mar-19 Deputies received a report that someone had tampered with and entered a vehicle in the 600 block of Date Ave, which caused damage. Nothing was discovered missing.

14-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a medical in the 400 block of Birch Ave. The coroner was called in after life saving measures did not work.

Deputies received a report of a forged check at Davis Brothers. Upon further investigation, Aaron Valdez was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Valdez was later released on a \$5,000.00 bond. UPDATE: After further investigation into this case, deputies issued warrants for Andrew Towers and Nicole Spicknall for their involvement in the case. On March 11, 2019, Nicole Spicknall was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Spicknall is being held on a \$1,500.00 bond. Towers is currently being held in Yuma County on an unrelated matter. Spicknall and Towers are both being charged with Forgery.
