03/15/19 through 03/22/19

- 15-Mar-19 Deputies responded to a residence in the Hyde area for a carbon monoxide exposure. Upon arrival deputies were told that the party had been transported to the hospital by a family member.
- 16-Mar-19 While in custody, Ryan Lamoreaux was arrested on a Washington County warrant for failure to comply. Lamoreaux was later released on a \$2,000.00 PR bond.
- 16-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to an abandoned vehicle located on CO RD Z a few miles south of CO RD 9 that was stuck in a snowdrift from our recent storm. The vehicle was later towed by Z & Z Towing.
- 17-Mar-19 Deputies were contacted by Colorado State Patrol about a dog at large on Hwy 34 at MM 191. The dog was taken to the Akron Pound and the owner later claimed the dog.
- 17-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a family disturbance in the Town of Akron. The juvenile and his mother later met with Centennial Mental Health.
- 17-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a family disturbance in the Town of Akron. One of the parties was taken to a relative's house. No criminal activity had taken place.
- 18-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to CO RD RR and CO RD 6 on a report of theft. Upon further investigation it was determined that the suspect(s) had stolen copper wire. Case is under investigation.
- 18-Mar-19 Deputies received a report from a Lone Star resident of a missing firearm. The firearm was entered into the system as stolen.
- 19-Mar-19 Deputies received a report from the Department of Human Services of a Violation of a Protection Order. After investigation it was determined that no violation had occurred.
- 19-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a stolen ATV on CO RD 50 at approximately CO RD V. While deputies were enroute to that location they were advised the ATV had been taken by a person who had just been in a vehicle crash just west of the residence. Deputies arrived on scene and talked to the driver who admitted to being under the influence at the time of the crash. Colorado State Patrol took custody of the driver.
- 20-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a dog bite in the Platner area. Case is under investigation.
- 21-Mar-19 While in custody, Hyon Kim was arrested on a warrant out of Nebraska and Indiana. Kim is being held pending extradition.
