22-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a dog that had been hit by a semi on 1st & Cedar. The dog was taken to the vet but later died due to its injuries.

23-Mar-19 Deputies were dispatched to a possible theft from a vehicle at the Akron High School during the Akron Wrestling Tournament. Case is under investigation.

25-Mar-19 Deputies received a call about a possible family disturbance in Washington County. Case is under investigation.

25-Mar-19 Deputies were contacted by Sterling Police Department to assist in identifying a suspect in a burglary that occurred in the Sterling area. Deputies provided mugshots of the possible suspect to the Sterling Police Department.
