

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

04/05/19 through 04/12/19

05-Apr-19 While on patrol in Akron deputies noticed a resident that had a calf in their yard. Deputies notified the resident that they could not possess the calf in the Town of Akron. Resident agreed to relocate the calf.

05-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to a juvenile problem in the Woodrow area. After further investigation, deputies determined that nothing criminal had occurred.
