- 13-Apr-19 Deputies responded to a family disturbance in the Town of Akron in which one of the parties exhibited mental health issues. The party was referred to Centennial Mental Health.
- 14-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to the 700 block of Ash Ave in the Town of Akron for a vehicle being broken in to. Deputies arrived on scene and observed several vehicles in which the doors were left unlocked and someone had gone through the center consoles and glove compartments. Deputies also received reports of vehicles being gone through in the 600 and 700 blocks of Birch Ave. Case is under investigation.
- 14-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to a car vs. telephone pole on 5<sup>th</sup> and Cedar in the Town of Akron. Upon arrival deputies observed a vehicle on the side walk on the west side of Cedar. Harry Holmsten was issued a citation for Careless Driving.
- 16-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to an animal bite on Hwy 34. The dog was put on a 10 day quarantine.
- 16-Apr-19 Deputies were contacted by the Washington County Department of Human Services about a report of an adult protection issue. Department of Human Services reported that there were allegations of assault. Case is under investigation.
- 17-Apr-19 Deputies received a phone call of a bad check being passed in Anton. Case is under investigation.
- 18-Apr-19 Deputies arrested Vanessa Loomis on a warrant out of Washington County Courts for failure to appear. Loomis is being held on a \$500.00 bond.
