

# WASHINGTON COUNTY

04/26/19 through 05/03/19

26-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to a residence located east of Woodrow on a report of a possible trespass. After further investigation it was determined it was a civil matter and no crime was committed.

26-Apr-19 Deputies received a call from a concerned citizen about the welfare of a dog in the 400 block of Custer in the Town of Akron. Deputies located the animal and the issues were brought to the owner's attention. The owners took care of the problem immediately.

27-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to a residence in the 300 block of Ash Ave in the Town of Akron about the feral cat population. Deputies contacted the party that has been feeding them and the party agreed to stop feeding the feral cats.

28-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to a two vehicle traffic accident on Hwy 36 and MM 180. When deputies arrived on scene they observed two vehicles in the highway in what looked to be a head on collision. It was determined that the party in one of the vehicles was deceased and the party in the other vehicle was transported to an area hospital. Colorado State Patrol took over the crash scene.

29-Apr-19 Deputies were dispatched to a possible family disturbance on Hwy 63. When deputies arrived on scene they arrested Victoria Dunlavy for harassment/domestic violence. Dunlavy was later released on a \$1,000.00 bond.

30-Apr-19 Deputies were called to a dog at large in the 30000 block on CR N east of Woodrow. Deputies determined that it was part of a protection order and also a civil matter.

01-May-19 Deputies were dispatched to a possible family disturbance. Deputies spoke with the reporting party and determined that nothing criminal had taken place.

01-May-19 Deputies arrested Timothy Kelly on three warrants out of Logan County. Kelly is being held on a combined \$14,000.00 bond.

02-May-19 Deputies received a report of a stolen/lost license plate in the Town of Akron. A short time later the party called back and advised that the license plate had been located.
