- 24-May-19 Deputies assisted probation with home checks and during one of the checks deputies arrested Kenneth Thompson on a probation violation. Thompson is being held on an \$11,000.00 bond.
- 24-May-19 Deputies were advised of an ordinance violation in the Town of Akron.
- 24-May-19 Deputies arrested Kimberly Gooden on a warrant out of Yuma County District Court. Gooden is being held without bond.
- 26-May-19 Deputies received a call about harassment in the Town of Otis. The parties were told to quit or they would be charged.
- 26-May-19 Deputies were dispatched to a residence in the Town of Akron for an unwanted party. Upon arrival deputies determined that nothing criminal had taken place and the unwanted party left for the night.
- 28-May-19 Deputies received a report of a possible sexual exploitation of a child in the Town of Otis. Case is under investigation.
