06/07/19 through 06/14/19

07-Jun-19 Deputies trapped 2 cats on Fremont Ave in the Town of Akron. One of the cats was released to its owner; the other cat was later adopted.

07-Jun-19 Deputies were dispatched to a roll-over crash in the vicinity of CO RD 12 & CO RD LL. Colorado State Patrol took over the crash.

09-Jun-19 Deputies were dispatched to a disturbance in the Family Dollar parking lot. Upon arrival it was determined that it was 2 juveniles playing around. Nothing criminal had occurred.
