06/28/19 through 07/05/19

28-Jun-19 Deputies received a report of a possible elder abuse situation. Deputies and Department of Human Services are conducting an investigation into the matter.

28-Jun-19 While in custody, Matthew Anderson was arrested on a 3 warrants out of Denver County and Lakewood Municipal Court. Anderson was later transported to Denver City Jail.

28-Jun-19 Deputies were dispatched to a dog at large in the Town of Akron. The dog was located and taken to the Akron Pound. The owner, Sheryl Bohm later picked up the dog and was given a warning for dog at large.

28-Jun-19 Deputies were notified of an abandoned bicycle on Hwy 6 at mile marker 387. The bicycle was picked up and brought to the sheriff's office.

29-Jun-19 Deputies were dispatched to the 700 block of Birch for a domestic violence incident. Upon further investigation, Luis Torres Agron was arrested for violation of a protection order, 1st degree criminal trespass, and domestic violence. Torres Agron was later released on a \$2500.00 surety bond.

01-Jul-19 Deputies received a report of a prowler that was attempting to break into cars near Railroad and Gum Ave. The prowler had broken into one car at CHS and was attempting to break into another. When deputies arrived they observed a party matching the description given. Bryan Lubang was arrested on 1st degree criminal trespass. Lubang was later released on a \$1,000.00 co-signed PR Bond.

01-Jul-19 Deputies were notified of 3 cats that were caught in traps set by Animal Control Officers. The cats were taken to the pound and flyers were hung up around the Town of Akron.

02-Jul-19 Deputies were notified of a fire hydrant that was knocked over in a hit and run accident. The fire chief was notified. Case is under investigation.

03-Jul-19 Deputies were dispatched to a suspicious vehicle and person in the 800 block of Grand Ave. Upon arrival, deputies located the vehicle and person and arrested David Hernandez Martinez on a Morgan County warrant, the vehicle was towed until the party provides proof of ownership. Hernandez Martinez is being held pending advisement.

03-Jul-19 Deputies received a report of a feral cat and kittens in the 600 block of Adams. Deputies took the cat and kittens to the pound and posted flyers around the Town of Akron. The owner later came to pick up the cat and kittens.

04-Jul-19 While in custody, Luis Torres Agron was arrested on a Morgan County for failure to appear. Torres Agron was later released on a \$5,000.00 bond.
