07/05/19 through 07/12/19

05-Jul-19 Deputies were dispatched to a family disturbance in the 500 block of Cedar Ave in the Town of Akron. After investigation it was determined that nothing criminal had taken place.

05-Jul-19 Deputies received a report of an ongoing harassment issue. The victims did not wish to press charges they just wanted the incident documented.
