07/19/19 through 07/26/19

19-Jul-19 Deputies stopped a vehicle on Hwy 34 for speeding. Upon running the party, Joan Mendoza-Diaz it was determined that he had a misdemeanor warrant out of Phillips County. Mendoza-Diaz was later released on a \$250.00 bond.

19--Jul-19 Deputies received a call about a welfare check in the Platner Area. Deputies discovered that the party was in the hospital and let the concerned party know.

19-Jul-19 Deputies were dispatched to a two car accident on 6th and Cedar Ave in the Town of Akron. Upon further investigation, Mariah Aucoin was cited for failure to yield right of way. There were no injuries.

19-Jul-19 Deputies were dispatched to the Yuma District Hospital on a dog bite the occurred in the Town of Akron. The dog was up to date on shots and is on a 10 day home quarantine.

25-Jul-19 Deputies were dispatched to a two vehicle accident on 1st & Cedar Ave in the Town of Akron. Upon further investigation, Cecelia Spaulding was cited for failure to yield right of way. There were no injuries.

26-Jul-19 Deputies were dispatched to the Prewitt Reservoir for a possible domestic violence. Upon arrival to the reservoir, deputies found Matthew Kramer in violation of a protection order. Deputies also found methamphetamine located in the vicinity of Kramer and three children. Kramer was arrested and charged with violation of a protection order, unlawful possession of a schedule 2 controlled substance, attempt to influence of public servant, and child abuse. Kramer is being held without bond pending advisement.
