Press Release

08/09/19 through 08/16/19

August 9, 2019

Deputies received a report of an intoxicated man leaving the Akron Clinic. Deputies attempted to catch up to the vehicle in Washington County but the vehicle had already made it to Morgan County.

Deputies were dispatched to a person being chased with a gun in the Town of Otis. Upon further investigation it was determined the case was unfounded.

August 10, 2019

Deputies received a report of a runaway juvenile in the Lindon area. Deputies were able to find the juvenile and contacted DHS.

Deputies received a report from JD's Quik Stop of a gas drive off. The party that drove off later came back and paid for the gas.

Deputies had a dog at large in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the pound and released to the owner, Dillon Armstrong. Armstrong was also given a ticket for dog at large.

August 11, 2019

Deputies observed a house with overgrown weeds. Deputies contacted the resident and gave them a week to take care of the issue.

Deputies were notified of a dog bite at the Yuma District Hospital which occurred in Washington County. The dog was put on a 10 day home quarantine.

August 12, 2019

Deputies received a report of a dog at large on Cedar and 1st in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the pound and flyers were placed around town. The owner, Mariah Lightle later picked up the dog and was given a verbal warning for dog at large.

While in custody, Nathan McCoy was arrested on a warrant out of Jefferson County. McCoy was later released on a \$2,000.00 bond.

August 13, 2019

While in custody, Jaime Tiscareno-Deandra was arrested on a warrant out of Adams County Court. Tiscareno-Deandra is being held on a \$75,000.00 bond.

Deputies received a report from a resident in Akron that someone had driven past his house and flicked a cigarette into his yard. The resident could describe the vehicle and the person but wasn't sure who the party was.

August 14, 2019

A cell phone was found in the lobby at the Washington County Sheriff's Office. The owner of the phone later came in to the Sheriff's Office to claim the phone.

While in custody, Edward Jones was arrested on a warrant out of Denver District Court. Jones is being held pending advisement.

Deputies received a report of a dog bite that had occurred approximately 4 weeks ago. The party that was bitten did not wish to press charges and just wanted to notify the Washington County Sheriff's Office of what had occurred.
