

WASHINGTON COUNTY

09/20/19 through 09/27/19

September 21, 2019

Deputies received an anonymous report of a party with underage drinking. After investigation, it was determined that no underage drinking was happening.

Deputies attempted to stop a vehicle but the vehicle took off at a high rate of speed. Due to unsafe speed on dirt roads the pursuit was called off. Deputies later responded to a suspicious vehicle in a field just west of CO RD Y and CO RD 56. Once deputies arrived on scene they confirmed that the vehicle was the one from the pursuit and was also reported stolen out of Ft. Morgan. Deputies are working with Ft. Morgan Police Department on this case.

Deputies observed a dog running at large in the 100 block of Bent in the Town of Akron. The dog was taken to the Akron pound and flyers were placed around town in order to find the owner.

Deputies received a report of a stolen vehicle from the Town of Akron. The vehicle was entered into the system as stolen. The vehicle was later recovered in the Town of Brush.

September 22, 2019

Deputies assisted EMS on a medical. The party made criminal accusations against her husband. Deputies investigated the matter and found nothing criminal had occurred.

September 23, 2019

Deputies received a report of a tractor trailer truck traveling south on Cedar Ave that failed to stop at the intersection on 1st St. Deputies contacted the driver, William Park and cited him for disregarding a stop sign at a through street.

Deputies were dispatched to a non injury accident at the Akron Post Office. Jeanine Vanderford was issued a citation for limitations on backing.
