October 4, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to a domestic disturbance in the 500 block of Custer Ave in the Town of Akron. After further investigation, deputies arrested Jessica Hartgers for assault, criminal mischief, harassment and domestic violence. Hartgers was later released on a \$1,000.00 PR bond.

Deputies received a report of an identity theft in Washington County. Case is under investigation.

Deputies received a report about juvenile removing money from a tip jar at a local business. The juvenile was identified and the money was returned to the business. No criminal charges are being filed and the matter will be addressed by the parents.

October 5, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to the Anton area for possible suicidal party. The party was located and was fine.
