11/01/19 through 11/08/19

November 2, 2019

Deputies received a phone call about children not being properly fastened into car seats. When deputies arrived they determined that the issue was more than just the children being fastened into the car seat and that it was a civil issue.

Deputies arrested Devin Canny on a warrant out of Morgan County for failure to comply. Canny was later released on a \$5,000.00 bond.

November 4, 2019

Deputies received a report of a wallet that had been found. Deputies are trying to locate the party.

November 5, 2019

Deputies received a call about stolen tools in the Cope area. Case is under investigation.

Deputies received a report of a party that had an accidental gunshot wound. The party was taken to the hospital and deputies determined that it was accidental and nothing criminal had occurred.

Deputies were dispatched to a possible domestic disturbance in the Town of Akron. Darrell Phelps was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. Phelps was later released on a \$500.00 PR bond.

Deputies received a report of a dog bite that occurred in Washington County. The dog was taken to the pound for a 10 day quarantine.

Deputies received a report of disturbance at a residence in the Town of Akron. When deputies arrived the parties were separated and it was determined nothing criminal had occurred.

Deputies found a wallet in the 700 block of Main St. in the Town of Akron. Deputies were able to locate the party and give the wallet back.

Deputies were dispatched to a party trying to get into vehicles around 5th and Adams. The party Larry Cecil was later located and arrested for possession of methamphetamines. Cecil is being held pending advisement.

Deputies received a report of a juvenile that was suicidal. Deputies contacted the party and the family said they would monitor the situation. The juvenile was referred to the crisis hotline.

Deputies were dispatched to a car vs deer crash on Hwy 34. Colorado State Patrol took over the crash scene.
