Press Release

11/15/19 through 11/22/19

November 16, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to a single rollover crash just west of Akron on Hwy 34. When deputies arrived they found the party unresponsive. First responders determined that the driver was deceased at the scene. Colorado State Patrol took over the crash scene.

November 18, 2019

Deputies were dispatched to an unattended death in the 700 block of Cedar Ave in the Town of Akron. The coroner was called and took over the scene.

Deputies received a call of a theft from the Anton Coop in Anton. Numerous items were taken. Case is under investigation.

Deputies received a call of an identity theft. The party told deputies that he has had multiple issues with the television company and wanted to report it in hopes of resolving the issue. Case is under investigation.

While in custody, Daniel Jobe was arrested on a warrant out of Denver Police Department for motor vehicle theft. Jobe is being held on a \$5,000.00 bond.
